

Per the City of Algonac “**2012 Fireworks Ordinance**” a person shall not ignite, discharge, or use consumer fireworks, except on the day preceding, the day of, or the day after a national holiday:

- 1 New Year’s Day, January 1
- 2 Martin Luther King Jr.’s Birthday, the third Monday in January
- 3 President’s Day, the third Monday in February
- 4 Memorial Day, the last Monday in May
- 5 Independence Day, July 4
- 6 Labor Day, the first Monday in September
- 7 Columbus Day, the second Monday in October
- 8 Veteran’s Day, November 11
- 9 Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November
- 10 Christmas Day, December 25

A minor shall not possess, ignite, discharge or use consumer fireworks.

Consumer fireworks shall not be ignited, discharged or used between the hours of 11 pm and 7 am on the specified national holidays, except on New Year’s Day, consumer fireworks shall not be ignited, discharged or used between the hours of 1:00 am and 7:00 am.

A violation of this ordinance is a municipal civil infraction, punishable by a fine of up to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), plus the costs of prosecution.
