City property tax bills will be issued July 1, 2016. Property taxes are due August 31, 2016 (postmark not accepted). Failure to pay property taxes on time will result in the following penalties: a four (4) percent penalty will be added to all unpaid balances on September 1, 2016; thereafter, on the first day of October and of each succeeding month, additional interest/penalty of one-half of one percent shall be added. Such collection charges shall not exceed six (6) percent.

The Treasurer of the City of Algonac is currently accepting applications for summer 2016 tax deferments for taxes due on principal residences. The deadline for filing a deferment application is September 14, 2016.

- 1). To qualify, a household income for the preceding calendar year cannot exceed \$40,000. The applicant must also be:
 - a. 62 years of age or older, including the unmarried surviving spouse if a person who was 62 years or older at the time of death;
 - b. Paraplegic or quadriplegic;
 - c. Eligible Serviceperson, eligible Veteran, eligible widow or widower;
 - d. Blind person;
 - e. Totally and permanently disabled.

2) The property is classified or used as agriculture real property, and that the gross receipts of agricultural or horticultural operations in the previous year (or average gross receipts for such operations in the previous three (3) years) is not less than the household income of the preceding calendar year.

If approved, deferment of summer taxes without penalty or interest charges will be until February 14, 2017. A tax deferment form can be obtained

The deferment applications can be obtained and taxes can be paid during normal business hours, 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. at the Algonac City Hall, 805 St. Clair River Drive. You may also print the form off of our website at www.algonac-mi.gov and mail the form as well if you cannot get into the office prior to the filing date.
